




1. On-Resistance vs. Drain Current




3. On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage







4. Drain-to-Source Forward Voltage




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

VDS Drain to Source Voltage (V)


9. Safe Operating Area

11. Normalized Thermal Transient Junction to Ambient




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
